## **SUNY SCHENECTADY**

### **ACQUIRED IMMUNE DEFICIENCY SYNDROME POLICY**

SUNY Schenectady, recognizing its obligation to educate its staff and students and promote a better understanding of Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS) related issues, supports the following policy:

1. The College will not discriminate against individuals who are diagnosed with Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) positive or diagnosed with AIDS Related Complex (ARC) or AIDS.
2. The primary response of the College to the AIDS epidemic will be education, i.e., providing educational programs and training sessions for students, faculty and staff; providing referral services for those students, faculty or staff requesting it; and developing and implementing uniform safety precautions to prevent the accidental transmission of AIDS and AIDS-related diseases.
