Please read the information below carefully before completing your registration.

• <u>STEP 1:</u> Online registration opens on February 1st 2023 and must be completed no later than FEBRUARY 28, 2022. No late applications will be accepted!

Tuition: \$195 – 3 Credit Course; \$260 – 4 Credit Course

 <u>STEP 2</u>: Non-Schenectady County Residents must obtain a Certificate of Residence (COR) from their county of residence and submit that to their instructor no later than February 27, 2023.
 Failure to submit a COR will result in a non-resident rate of pay

Please note if you submitted a COR in the FALL OF 2022, you do NOT have to submit another one. *Schenectady county residents do NOT need to submit anything*

- Certificates of residence can be obtained at the County Treasurer's office.
 Please contact your county treasurer for specifics.

- <u>STEP 4:</u> Financial Hardship "Access" Scholarship and waivers for free/reduced lunch participants are available. Free and Reduced status is verified with each school district.
