

Scholarship Application

Students use an online application system to apply for scholarships. Through this system, students can log in using their Angel username and password to submit a "common app" for the majority of scholarships. The common app requires a 300-500 word essay response, as well as other biographical information that can give the student a better chance at being selected.

Some scholarships require additional materials, such as a second essay or a letter of recommendation. Students who wish to be considered for these are asked to upload these materials to the website to complete their application. Upon uploading all required materials, students are automatically considered for the scholarships and are notified 1-2 months after the deadline.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT are these scholarships?

Awards are open to full-time and part-time students, based on academic performance, degree program, career goals, personal interests, and/or financial need. These scholarships are specifically reserved for students who have been enrolled in at least one semester at SCCC.

WHO can apply for scholarships?

- **Incoming** students who are seeking scholarships as they begin at SCCC
- Continuing students who are seeking scholarships for their second year at SCCC
- **Graduating** students* who are seeking scholarships after completing their SCCC degree

*Most scholarships are available to current or incoming students. Graduating students are encouraged to contact their transfer college or university for scholarship opportunities.

WHEN do I apply?

Applications open during Spring 2017 semester. Specific dates will be posted.
