- **Register online with [College Central Network](#)** to explore careers, access career events, research employers, learn to write resumes and cover letters, prepare for interviews, and create your online portfolio.
- **Schedule Regular Appointments** with a career advisor to discuss your interests and goals, assess your personal strengths and talents, and learn about additional resources based on your needs.
- **Do your best in classes and labs.** Speak with SCCC faculty to get the most out of your classes, receive job search advice, develop leads, and request letters of recommendation. Speak with classmates to generate leads and insight.

- **Explore ways to build experience** such as becoming an intern or volunteer. This is the best way to build experience as a student and is often the reason you are hired after graduation. Contact your Department Dean or the Career & Transfer Office for assistance.
