

Christian Fellowship Club

Article I.

The first purpose of the club is to worship God through song, prayer and study of his Word. Second is to provide fellowship and spiritual support for other Christians, as well as reaching out to deliver God's message of salvation through Jesus Christ to anyone who may be interested.

Article II.

Attendance is open and all are welcome regardless of denominational orientation. There are no mandatory dues, but they will be accepted on a voluntary basis.

Article III.

Meetings are held during College Hour (11:30 - 12:30) on Tuesdays in a room to be announced each semester.

Article IV.

Officers of the club shall be the President, Vice President, Secretary and the Treasurer.

Article V.

Duties of the officers are as follows: attendance is mandatory for the President and Secretary. The President and Vice President maintain order and execute club activities. In the absence of the President, the next officer takes the lead in the order listed in the previous Article. The Secretary records club minutes, forwards these to the SGA, and maintains any other club records. The Treasurer maintains financial records in compliance with SGA and coordinates all fund raising activities according to SGA policy and procedures.

Article VI.

Officers are nominated based upon past and present displayed commitment to attendance and scriptural principles. Nominees are chosen by the agreement of all remaining officers. If an officer begins to display traits which contradict the principles of scripture, he may be removed by the agreement of all remaining officers.

Article VII.

Changes to this document will require the organization of an entirely new club. We will not officially become involved with religious contentions which contradict the authority of the scripture of the Holy Bible as the authentic Word of God.
