

SUNY General Education Requirement for all SCCC A.A. and A.S. Programs

The SUNY General Education Requirement states that baccalaureate degree candidates, as a condition of graduation, must complete an academically rigorous and comprehensive core General Education curriculum of no fewer than 30 credit hours. The SCCC SUNY General Education Requirement is designed to provide a solid foundation for your college education and to make transfer to a SUNY institution as smooth and seamless as possible. The Associate of Art and Associate of Science curricula at SCCC include a minimum 30 credits of the required 30 General Education credit hours. You must earn 30 credits in at least seven of the ten SUNY-GER subject areas and demonstrate two competencies. Your academic advisor can help you plan a path to meet your SUNY General Education Requirement. The courses listed below satisfy the General Education requirement in each of the designated academic areas.
