NOTES:

- (a) To fulfill the Honors Civilization requirement, students must take both HON 125 and HON 234.
- (b) Any course with the LIT prefix satisfies this requirement.
- (c) The completion of one year of any language other than English (Elementary 1 & 2, or higher) is the minimum program requirement. High school courses may count toward satisfying this requirement but only if students receive A.P. or College in the High School (CHS) credit per the SCCC Academic Code. CLEP credit is also acceptable. ASL 121 and ASL 122 do not satisfy this requirement but can be taken as Humanities electives.
- (d) Honors Program students must take a course that expressly considers cultural differences and diversity from among SOC 228 (Minority-Majority Relations in the U.S.), HIS 233 (Women and Gender in the U.S.), LIT211 (Native American Literature), LIT 214 (African American Literature), LIT 220 (Women's Literature), LIT 221 (Hispanic Literature of the Western Hemisphere), HIS 130 (Introduction to Black History in the United States), HIS 241 (European Witch Trials), MUS 131 (African American Music Survey), MUS 127 (Jazz Styles and Development), HIS 237 (Introduction to Chinese History), MUS 115 Rock Music Style and Development), HIS 231 (Russian History), or REL 121 (World Religions).
- (e) The Restricted Arts elective can be satisfied by any course from the SCCC SUNY General Education list in the Arts category.
- (f) Courses with the ANT, PSY, and SOC prefix satisfy this requirement.
- (g) All courses with the ECO, HIS, PHI, and POL prefix satisfy this requirement. Students intending to transfer to a SUNY school are advised to take a semester of American History.
- (h) Before selecting science courses, Students should carefully review the science requirements of the college to which they plan to transfer. Honors Program students must take one semester of a laboratory course from among BIO 141, or higher; CHM 121, or higher; GEO 141 or 143, or PHY 153, or higher.

To graduate from the Honors Concentration, students must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 and have completed all the curriculum requirements of the program.
